Limited edition made for STUDIO 47

KAI CB-2 is the exact reproduction of the pattern found on a cutting mat for textile use, manufactured by Japanese brand KAI. All the additional marks on these mats are meant to simplify the cutting of basic patterns out of fabric with a rolling cutter. The pattern was redrawn as vectors and enlarged around 30% for better display of small details. The scarf is 80 x 100 cm in size and was silkscreened on 100% silk. It comes in a silkscreened box (23 x 23 x 4 cm) and was all printed and seamed by hand with an edition of 10 + 3 A.P., numbered and signed. The price is 120€. The sales of the scarf will be used for 50% to support the program of STUDIO 47 and for 50% to support upcoming projects of Centerfold Editions.

Fernández Fuentes (Barcelona, 1980) studied in Barcelona and London before graduating in 2008 from the Graphic Design department at the Gerrit Rietveld Academie in Amsterdam. Since then he works as an autonomous graphic designer, often in collaboration with artists, photographers and other designers.
